

MDS Due

Setup:

From the HQ Home page, access the "MDS Settings" form, located under the MDS module...



Scroll to the bottom of this form, to the blue section header that reads "MDS Due Settings". There are four color fields (ARD Days Color, Grace Days Color, Optimized Day Color, and LOA Days Color), two gray color fields (ARD Days Gray and Grace Days Gray). The system default is shown in the screen-shot below. If you would like different colors, then you can <u>Google</u> "HTML Color Picker" to lookup different colors. You should also select the number of Drop Off Days, this is how long the Due Assessment will show on the report before it falls off.

Use:

From the HQ Home page, you will see "MDS3 Reports", located under the MDS module



From the "MDS Reports", you should see "MDS Due" listed, select this option, and the report should pull up.



First, you need to enter a start date, this date MUST be today or later. You cannot pull the report for past dates. If you do not wish to use colors, then you can select the Grayscale" checkbox. Once you have a start date, you can select the "Update" button.
